

Rules of use and declaration of consent

Kletterinsel Fürstenfeld, R. Gladiator und W. Jensen GbR, Version: March 1, 2020

Yellow parcours, green parcours, Flying Fox lower level:

Minimum age: 6 years; minimum height: 1.25m, **two climbing children must be accompanied by one climbing adult**

Yellow parcours, green parcours, red parcours, Flying Fox lower and upper level:

Minimum age: 8 years; minimum height: 1.30m

Blue parcours:

Minimum age: 11 years; minimum height: 1.30m

Rules for those accompanying children:

- 6-7 years of age: 2 children per accompanying adult who must climb and assist the children
- 8-12 years of age: 5 children per accompanying adult who need not to climb but should be in reach.
- Persons aged 13 and older are allowed to climb all exercise courses without an accompanying adult.
- Accompanying adults must keep the children in sight at all times
- **The rules of use must be signed by a parent/guardian**

General regulations:

1. All Kletterinsel visitors must be in a healthy physical and mental state. If in doubt, ask our safety staff and inform us of any possible adverse effects. Attendance is prohibited to those under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
2. Before using the high ropes course, each participant must complete the safety briefing.
3. Safety equipment includes a harness, a helmet and 2 self-locking carabiner snap hooks. The safety equipment given out is not transferable and should not be taken off during the course of the visit. If the equipment has to be taken off (e.g. to go to the toilet), your equipment must be re-checked by a safety trainer before you may climb again. Safety equipment must not be taken outside Kletterinsel.
4. Smoking whilst wearing the harness is strictly forbidden.
5. After their briefing, the participants are responsible for their own safety. Moving around the site is on one's own responsibility. Please comply with our signs and all safety rules. Please proceed very carefully and attentively, both with regard to one's own safety and to the safety system in place. Serious injury may otherwise result.
6. In general, when moving around the high ropes course, both carabiners are to be hooked onto the safety wire. Every time when reaching the point to move from one security rope to the next, one carabiner will remain hooked. Both carabiners must not be unhooked simultaneously. If in doubt, please contact a safety trainer.
7. When moving around the high ropes course, objects which may be dangerous for the participants themselves or for others (jewellery, cameras, mobile phones, etc.) must be stowed away safely. Piercings, whether exposed or not, must be removed. Scarves etc. must be removed and long hair tied back.

Each single exercise may be performed by only one person at a time. A maximum of 3 people at one time may remain on a small platform. The zip lines may only be used if it is ensured that there is no-one in the landing area or in the zip line.

8. Climbing is terminated to a maximum of 2,5 hours, beginning after the safety briefing. Thereafter, an additional payment charge of €5 per hour or part thereof must be paid. Please be aware of our opening times, as these vary, depending on the season and weather conditions. If the climbing time remains under 2,5 hours due to the opening times, there is no entitlement to a refund or extension of opening times. Likewise, there is no entitlement to a refund of the entry fee in the event of entry being cut short at the wish of the participant or due to an earlier, weather-related closure of the facility (storm, thunderstorm, heavy rain, hail, etc.).
9. The instructions given by the safety trainer must be followed strictly and immediately. Kletterinsel Fürstenfeld reserves the right to exclude individuals who do not comply with the safety rules or the instructions of the trainer.
10. By signing below, you acknowledge that you have read and understood the rules of use and agree to our "Terms and Conditions". You likewise confirm that there are no medical issues keeping you from climbing. In case of noncompliance or violation of the operator/trainer's instructions or safety requirements/regulations, Kletterinsel Fürstenfeld assumes no liability for the resulting damage. We assume no liability for clothes or objects left with us. Richard Gladiator und Walter Jensen GbR is liable only for the wilful misconduct or gross negligence of its legal representatives and employees.
